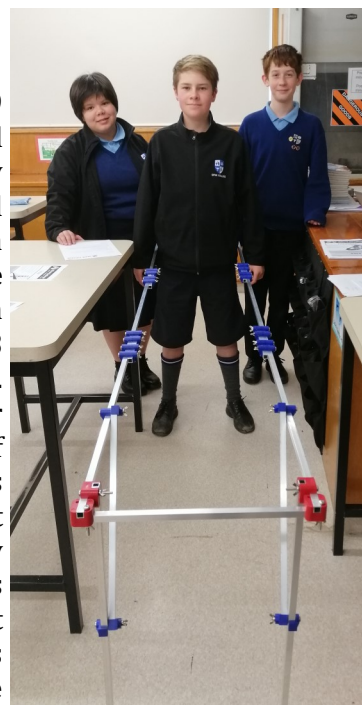
## RUGBY
