#### **Covid Update**

As with the rest of society, Covid is continuing to effect life here at school. Due to the nature of the virus the situation is very fluid and what is required is often changing. We endeavour to keep you informed but if you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact us.

You may have already received a request for details of your student's vaccination status. Under the Covid-19 Public Health Response (Vaccinations) Order 2021, secondary schools are required to maintain an up-to-date register with the vaccine status of all eligible students. This information is confidential and will be stored at the school. We will not share your personal information unless we are required or authorised to do so by law. In the situation of an outbreak, we may share your personal information with a Public Health Authority for the purposes of planning and implementing appropriate public health responses. Where possible we will only disclose aggregate level information.

For students who travel to school on a school bus we are expecting that the rules will change slightly, with face masks becoming mandatory for all people 12 years old or more.

We are still hoping to be able to run this year's Awards Ceremony as normal on the 13<sup>th</sup> December, however this is very dependent on the alert levels status at the time. As we do understand what a special event this is for the students, their whanau

and the staff here at Opihi College, we will make a final decision as late as possible.

#### **Senior Students**

Since the last newsletter the Ministry of Education has revised its stance on who is eligible for <u>Learning</u> <u>Recognition Credits</u>. Students at Opihi College do now qualify for the Learning Recognition Credits. Therefore, the following rules apply

- \* For every 5 credits a student earns towards their NCEA through assessment, they would be entitled to one extra Learning Recognition Credit to acknowledge the disruption to their learning.
- \* Students undertaking NCEA Level 1 would be eligible for up to a maximum of 8 additional credits, while those at Levels 2 or 3 would be eligible for up to a maximum of 6 additional credits.

#### Seniors Final Day and NCEA Exams

The end of the year is fast approaching for the Seniors with their final teaching day being the  $12^{th}$  November and the NCEA exams starting  $22^{nd}$  November. Teacher will be running tutorials between these dates and students sitting external exams are highly encouraged to attend. The exam timetable can be found on the NZQA website or by clicking <u>here</u>.

#### Last day of School

Our last day of school for 2021 is Monday 13<sup>th</sup> December. Year 7-10 students will attend school for that day. As discussed earlier we hope to being able to run the Awards Ceremony as planned for all students (Years 7-13) starting at 7pm at the Temuka Stadium.
