

BASKETBALL The Opihi College basketball teams have started the season well, already recording some good wins in the local competition.






OPIHI COLLEGE 'LOCAL LEGENDS'

2022 KIWI COMPETITION

The University of Canterbury is delighted to offer the and annual Kiwi English, Mathematics Science competitions for Primary, Intermediate and Secondary schools in years 5 to 10. The skills based Kiwi competitions are written by New Zealand teachers for New Zealand students and closely align with the New Zealand Curriculum. The online competitions will be run in the last 3 weeks of Term 2 and the first week of Term 3. Parents/ caregivers will be provided with an individual student report outlining student performance distributed by the school. All participating students will be awarded a certificate and a prize will be awarded to the top student in each competition. The cost for a student to participate is \$9.50 per competition entered. Students can get a letter to take home from either their English/Maths/Science teachers.
