ENROLMENT AT OPIHI COLLEGE FOR 2024

The board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Opihi College for next year. Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Application for enrolment can be made online (please visit the Opihi College website) or by completing hard copy forms available at our school office.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **15 October 2023**. This includes students applying to be treated as in-zone students under transition provisions. Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

The board has determined that **5** places are likely to be available for out-ofzone students next year. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot is required it will be held **24 October 2023**.

Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

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JAPANESE FIELD TRIP 2023

"Tadaima! We're home!"

Charlie Bryce-Gillett, Noah Drake, Toni Holding, Amelia Holland, Hazel Johnston, Tara Kereopa, Samantha McLellan, Tony Milne, Lyric Murray-Maaka, Lachlan Russell and teachers Kate Manson and Eric Lindblom travelled to Japan for a two week language study trip during the Term 3 holidays. After activating their Japan Rail Passes in Narita, they jumped on the Shinkansen (bullet train) and travelled across the country at 285kph to Kyoto. From Kyoto they made day trips to the temples and shrines in Kyoto and Nara; to the Peace Park in Hiroshima and a ferry ride to Miyajima Island; and to the huge Kaiyukan Aquarium and shopping in Osaka. They then travelled to a hot springs area on the Izu Peninsula and spent a few nights in a 100 year old Japanese inn. In Tokyo they visited many places like Asakusa, the Sky Tree, Akihabara, Harajuku and Shibuya. A day trip took them out to FujiQ Highland Amusement Park which is right next to Mt. Fuji. And they also spent a day at Nihon University Tsurugaoka High School with the students who had visited Opihi College in August this year. They had a lot of fun together catching up while making shiratama rice balls during a special home economics class. It was an amazing trip! Some new experiences for the students included navigating the Tokyo subway and Kyoto bus system, bullet trains, Japanese vending machines, karaoke, sleeping on a futon on tatami mats, computerised toilets and all of the very different, but mostly delicious food that they tried. Though it was only a short two weeks in Japan the students' lives were greatly enriched. They grew in maturity and self-confidence and improved their communication skills. We are very grateful to the Asia New Zealand Foundation and Nakashimato Co Ltd, Trust Aoraki Ltd (Crown Hotel & Temuka Hotel), the Lions Club of Temuka, Pub Charity Ltd (Empire Hotel) and also the Temuka community who generously supported our many fundraising activities.
