We have recently farewelled two valued members of our Board of Trustees:



At Opihi College we believe that if students have more agency over their courses, they are more engaged in their learning. We have certainly seen this to be true since we introduced the Choices Programme 3 years ago.

This year we would like to run an Expo on Monday  $13^{th}$  November in the school hall. The first session from 5:00 - 5:30 will be the formal explanation as to how the Choices Programme works. We highly recommend this session for all families that are new to the programme.

The second session from 5:30 - 6:00pm is for **everyone** who will be in Year 9 or 10 next year. This is when the new course booklets will be given out. During this session, there will be displays out which will give you a visual of the courses that are on offer for 2024. The teachers will also be there, so you can talk to them individually about what courses are best for your child.

Following this evening, we then run course confirmation interviews with the whanau, child and school. These will happen in the following week. These interviews will be booked online and the booking code will be emailed to you.
